We would also like to recognize the fencers and archers for their participation on the field, and especially Lord Gryffyth Jenner who shot especially well in the Allied Champions Shoot. Later in the month, St. George's hosted the War Orphans' Pity Party (WOPP.) As WOPP actually occurred after Pennsic this year, We were able to attend and had a blast. There were hats to be coveted, fierce steeds at joust, and Bocce with the Baroness. His Excellency looks especially charming in pearl-draped hats that resemble chandeliers.... September brought with it wishful thinking of cooler weather and the first Southern Atlantian Archery Day (SADD) in Sacred Stone. Later in the afternoon, the atl-atl throwers took over the range and were heard to jump and whoop with glee (really... it was kinda funny!) Look forward to this event next year! At the end of the month, still wishing for cooler weather, the (then) incipient Incipient Canton of Brockshire Abbey put on an amazing demo in support of the Hartsville Library. There was fighting, fencing, archery, jousting, bocce, food and so much more! We heartily congratulate Brockshire Abbey on a job well done, and special thanks to Cyddlian Downs for supporting them in their efforts.

Come October, we were all still wishing for cooler weather (really - when will fall come?) Most recently, at the War of the Wings II, where the Barony of Nottingham Coill did side with Our cousins Mark and Aelinor of Sacred Stone, We were amazed and delighted at the show of might put forth by Our Barony. Next to Sacred Stone and Black Diamond, Nottingham Coill had the largest contingent on the field. Our procession and declaration of allegiance to Sacred Stone won the Group Field Presence war point. His Excellency Talun led the Nottingham Coill forces on the heavy weapons field and did support Sacred Stone most nobly.
