Moments in Our Time

February

- 1 - 1327 The teenaged Edward III is crowned King of England, but the country is ruled by his mother Queen Isabella and her lover Roger Mortimer
- 3 - 1488 Bartolomeu Dias of Portugal lands in Mossel Bay after rounding the Cape of Good Hope at the tip of Africa, becoming the first known European to travel this far south
- 7 - 1301 Edward of Caernarvon (later King Edward II) becomes the first English Prince of Wales
- 8 - 1587 Mary, Queen of Scots is executed for suspicion of being involved in the Babington Plot to murder her cousin, Queen Elizabeth I
- 11 - 1531 Henry VIII of England is recognized as supreme head of the Church of England
- 12 - 1554 Lady Jane Gray is beheaded for treason, a year after claiming the throne of England for nine days
- 13 - 1542 Catherine Howard, the fifth wife of Henry VIII is executed for adultery
- 1575 Henry III of France is crowned at Rheims and marries Louise de Lorraine-Vandemont
- 14 - Valentine's Day - named after the Saint Valentinus of Terni, martyred in 270
- 1076 Pope Gregory VII excommunicates Henry IV, Holy Roman Emperor (he was excommunicated again in 1084 by Pope Victor III)
- 16 - 1249 Andrew of Longjumeau was dispatched by Louis IX of France as his ambassador to the Khan of the Mongols
- 1568 The entire population of the Netherlands - three million people - were sentenced to death by the Roman Catholic church for heresy, beginning the Dutch Revolt against Spain
- 18 - 1229 The Sixth Crusade: Frederick II, Holy Roman Emperor signs a ten year truce with al-Kamil, regaining Jerusalem, Nazareth, and Bethlehem with neither military engagements nor support from the papacy
- 20 - 1472 Orkney and Shetland are left by Norway to Scotland, due to a dowry payment
- 1548 Edward VI of England is crowned King of England at Westminster Abbey
- 21 1440 The Prussian Confederation is formed
- 22 1495 King Charles VIII of France enters Naples to claim the city's throne
- 23 1455 The Gutenberg Bible, the first Western book printed from movable type is published
- 24 1582 Pope Gregory XIII announces the Gregorian calendar, which is still in use today
- 25 1570 Pope Pius V excommunicates Queen Elizabeth I of England
- 26 1266 An army led by Charles, Count of Anjou defeats a combined German and Sicilian force led by King Manfred of Sicily at the Battle of Benevento. Manfred is killed in the battle and Pope Clement IV invests Charles as King of Sicily and Naples
- 29 1504 Christopher Columbus uses his knowledge of a lunar eclipse to convince Native American to provide him with supplies
