Singers rehearse and perform pre-17th century choral music at Pennsic and other SCA Wars. Membership in the choir is open to everyone who loves to sing!

The music for Pennsic 38 is available online in MIDI format as well as PDF from the Known World Choir Yahoo Group web page, or by postal mail from the director. You are strongly encouraged to learn the music before arriving at Pennsic – the better everyone knows their part, the better the concert will be! Walk-ins at Pennsic are welcome, just be prepared to work your vocal chords and your brain!
