Moments in Our Time

November

- 1 - 996 - Emperor Otto III issues a deed to Gottschalk, Bishop of Freising, which is the oldest known document using the name Ostarrîchi (Austria in Old High German).
1348 - The anti-royalist Union of Valencia attacks the Jews of Murviédro because they are serfs of the King of Valencia and thus "royalists".
1512 - The ceiling of the Sistine Chapel, painted by Michelangelo, is exhibited to the public for the first time.
1520 - The Strait of Magellan, the passage immediately south of mainland South America, connecting the Pacific and the Atlantic Oceans, is first navigated by Ferdinand Magellan during his global circumnavigation voyage.
- 2 - 1570 - A tidal wave in the North Sea devastates the coast from Holland to Jutland, killing more than 1,000 people.
- 3 - 644 - Umar ibn al-Khattab, the second Muslim caliph, is killed by a Persian slave in Medina.
1468 - Liège is sacked by Charles I of Burgundy's troops.
1493 - Christopher Columbus first sights the island of Dominica in the Caribbean Sea.
- 4 - 1333 - Flood of the Arno River, causing massive damage in Florence as recorded by the Florentine chronicler Giovanni Villani.
1501 - Catherine of Aragon (later Henry VIII's wife) meets Arthur Tudor, Henry VIII's older brother - they would later marry.
1576 - Eighty Years' War: In Flanders, Spain captures Antwerp (after three days the city was nearly destroyed).
- 5 - 1499 - Publication of the Catholicon in Treguier (Brittany). This Breton-French-Latin dictionary was written in 1464 by Jehan Lagadeuc. It is the first Breton dictionary as well as the first French dictionary.
1530 - St. Felix's Flood destroys the city of Reimerswaal in the Netherlands
- 6 - 1528 - Shipwrecked Spanish conquistador Álvar Núñez Cabeza de Vaca becomes the first known European to set foot in Texas.
- 7 - 1492 - The Ensisheim Meteorite, the oldest meteorite with a known date of impact, strikes the earth around noon in a wheat field outside the village of Ensisheim, Alsace, France.
- 8 - 1519 - Hernán Cortés enters Tenochtitlán and Aztec ruler Moctezuma welcomes him with great a celebration as would befit a returning god.
1520 - Stockholm Bloodbath begins: A successful invasion of Sweden by Danish forces results in the execution of around 100 people.
1576 - Eighty Years' War: Pacification of Ghent - The States-General of the Netherlands meet and unite to oppose Spanish occupation.
- 9 - 694 - Egica, a king of the Visigoths of Hispania, accuses Jews of aiding Muslims, sentencing all Jews to slavery.
1282 - Pope Martin IV excommunicates King Peter III of Aragon.
1313 - Louis the Bavarian defeats his cousin Frederick I of Austria at the Battle of Gamelsdorf.
1330 - Battle of Posada, Wallachian Voievode Basarab I defeats the Hungarian army in an ambush
1492 - Peace of Etaples between Henry VII and Charles VIII.
1494 - Family de' Medici become rulers of Florence.
- 10 - 1444 - Battle of Varna: The crusading forces of King Vladislaus III of Varna (aka Ulaszlo I of Hungary and Wladyslaw III of Poland) are crushed by the Turks under Sultan Murad II and Vladislaus is killed.
1520 - Danish King Christian II executes dozens of people in the Stockholm Bloodbath after a successful invasion of Sweden.
- 11 - 1215 - The Fourth Lateran Council meets, defining the doctrine of transubstantiation, the process by which bread and wine are transformed into the body and blood of Christ.
1500 - Treaty of Granada - Louis XII of France and Ferdinand II of Aragon agree to divide the Kingdom of Naples between them.
- 12 - 764 - Tibetan troops occupy Chang'an, the capital of the Chinese Tang Dynasty, for fifteen days.
1028 - Future Byzantine empress Zoe marries Romanus Argyrus according to the wishes of the dying Constantine VIII.
1439 - Plymouth, England, becomes the first town incorporated by the English Parliament.
1555 - The English Parliament re-establishes Catholicism.
- 13 - 1002 - English king Ethelred orders the killing of all Danes in England, known today as the St. Brice's Day massacre.
1160 - Marriage of Louis VII of France with Adele of Champagne.
- 14 - 1533 - Conquistadors from Spain under the leadership of Francisco Pizarro arrive in Cajamarca, Inca empire

- 15 - [655](#) - [Battle of Winwaed](#): [Penda of Mercia](#) is defeated by [Oswiu of Northumbria](#).
[1515](#) - [Thomas Cardinal Wolsey](#) is invested as a [Cardinal](#).
[1533](#) - [Francisco Pizarro](#) arrives in [Cuzco](#), the capital of the [Inca Empire](#).
- 16 - [534](#) - A second and final revision of the [Codex Justinianus](#) is published.
[1384](#) - [Jadwiga](#) is crowned [King of Poland](#), although she is a woman.
[1491](#) - An [auto de fe](#), held in the [Brasero de la Dehesa](#) outside of [Ávila](#), concludes the case of the [Holy Child of La Guardia](#) with the public execution of several [Jewish](#) and [converso](#) suspects.
[1532](#) - [Francisco Pizarro](#) and his men capture [Inca](#) Emperor [Atahualpa](#).
- 17 - [1292](#) - (O.S.) [John Balliol](#) becomes King of [Scotland](#).
[1511](#) - [Spain](#) and [England](#) ally against [France](#).
[1558](#) - [Elizabethan era](#) begins: Queen [Mary I of England](#) dies and is succeeded by her half-sister [Elizabeth I of England](#).
- 18 - [1302](#) - [Pope Boniface VIII](#) issues the [Papal bull](#) [Unam sanctam](#) (The Holy One).
[1307](#) - According to [legend](#), [William Tell](#) shoots an apple off of his son's head.
[1477](#) - [William Caxton](#) produces *Dictes or Sayengis of the Philosophres*, the first book printed on a [printing press](#) in [England](#).
[1493](#) - [Christopher Columbus](#) first sights what is now [Puerto Rico](#).
- 19 - [1095](#) - The [Council of Clermont](#), called by [Pope Urban II](#) to discuss sending the [First Crusade](#) to the [Holy Land](#), begins.
[1493](#) - [Christopher Columbus](#) goes ashore on an island he first saw the day before. He names it [San Juan Bautista](#) (later renamed [Puerto Rico](#)).
- 20 - [762](#) - [Bögü](#), [Khan](#) of the [Uyghurs](#), conquers [Lo-Yang](#), capital of the [Chinese Empire](#).
[1194](#) - [Palermo](#) is conquered by [Emperor Henry VI](#).
[1407](#) - A truce between [John the Fearless](#), [Duke of Burgundy](#) and [Louis of Valois](#), [Duke of Orléans](#) is agreed under the auspices of [John, Duke of Berry](#). [Orléans](#) would be assassinated three days later by Burgundy.
- 21 - [1272](#) - Following [Henry III of England's](#) death on [November 16](#), his son [Prince Edward](#) becomes [King of England](#).
- 22 - [845](#) : the first King of all [Brittany](#), [Nominoe](#) defeats the Frankish king [Charles the Bald](#) at the [Battle of Ballon](#) near [Redon](#).
- 23 - [800](#) - [Charlemagne](#) arrives at [Rome](#) to investigate the alleged crimes of [Pope Leo III](#).
[1227](#) - Polish [Prince Leszek I the White](#) is assassinated at an assembly of [Piast](#) dukes at [Gaşawa](#).
[1248](#) - Conquest of [Seville](#) by the Christian troops under King [Ferdinand III of Castile](#).
[1499](#) - Pretender to the throne [Perkin Warbeck](#) is hanged for reportedly attempting to escape from the [Tower of London](#). He had invaded [England](#) in [1497](#), claiming to be the lost son of King [Edward IV of England](#).
- 25 - [1034](#) - [Máel Coluim mac Cináeda](#), [King of Scots](#) dies. [Donnchad](#), the son of his second daughter [Bethóc](#) and [Crínán of Dunkeld](#), inherits the throne.
[1120](#) - The [White Ship](#) sinks in the [English Channel](#), drowning [William Adelin](#), son of [Henry I of England](#).
[1177](#) - [Baldwin IV of Jerusalem](#) and [Raynald of Chatillon](#) defeat [Saladin](#) at the [Battle of Montgisard](#).
[1491](#) - The [siege of Granada](#), last [Moorish](#) stronghold in [Spain](#), begins.
[1542](#) - [Battle of Solway Moss](#). The English army defeats the Scots.
- 26 - [1476](#) - [Vlad III Dracula](#) defeats [Basarab Laiota](#) with the help of [Stephen the Great](#) and [Stephen V Bathory](#) and becomes the ruler of [Wallachia](#) for the third time.
- 27 - [1095](#) - [Pope Urban II](#) declares the [First Crusade](#) at the [Council of Clermont](#).
[1295](#) - The first elected representatives from [Lancashire](#) were called to [Westminster](#) by [King Edward I](#) to attend what later became known as "[The Model Parliament](#)".
- 28 - [1095](#) - On the last day of the [Council of Clermont](#), [Pope Urban II](#) appoints Bishop [Adhemar of Le Puy](#) and [Count Raymond IV of Toulouse](#) to lead the [First Crusade](#) to the [Holy Land](#).
[1520](#) - After navigating through the [South American strait](#), three ships under the command of [Portuguese](#) explorer [Ferdinand Magellan](#) reach the [Pacific Ocean](#), becoming the first [Europeans](#) to sail from the [Atlantic Ocean](#) to the Pacific.
- [1582](#) - In [Stratford-upon-Avon](#), [William Shakespere](#) and [Anne Hathaway](#) pay a £40 bond for their [marriage license](#).
